# THE COURSE

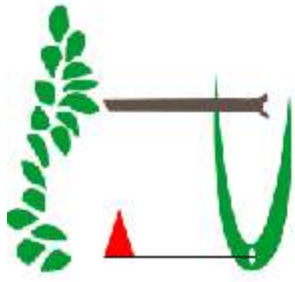
An 18 hole, 6509 yard, par 73 parkland course, which will prove a good test of your golfing abilities. The course is suitable for all golfers, whether you're experienced with a low handicap or a beginner and just starting to learn about the game.

The long undulating fairways, combined with water hazards on no fewer than 5 holes will be a test, from the 1st tee right up to the 18th hole. Our signature hole the par 4, 8th is just 367 yards long. A straight drive is required over a small pool, followed by a second shot over the main lake to an inviting green; you do have to hold your nerve.



The course has been much improved over the past 18 months and there is an ongoing plan to build on this. The improvements are being carried out under the watchful eye of newly appointed Ray Hayhurst, a vastly experienced head green keeper, who has prepared some of the top courses in the midlands.

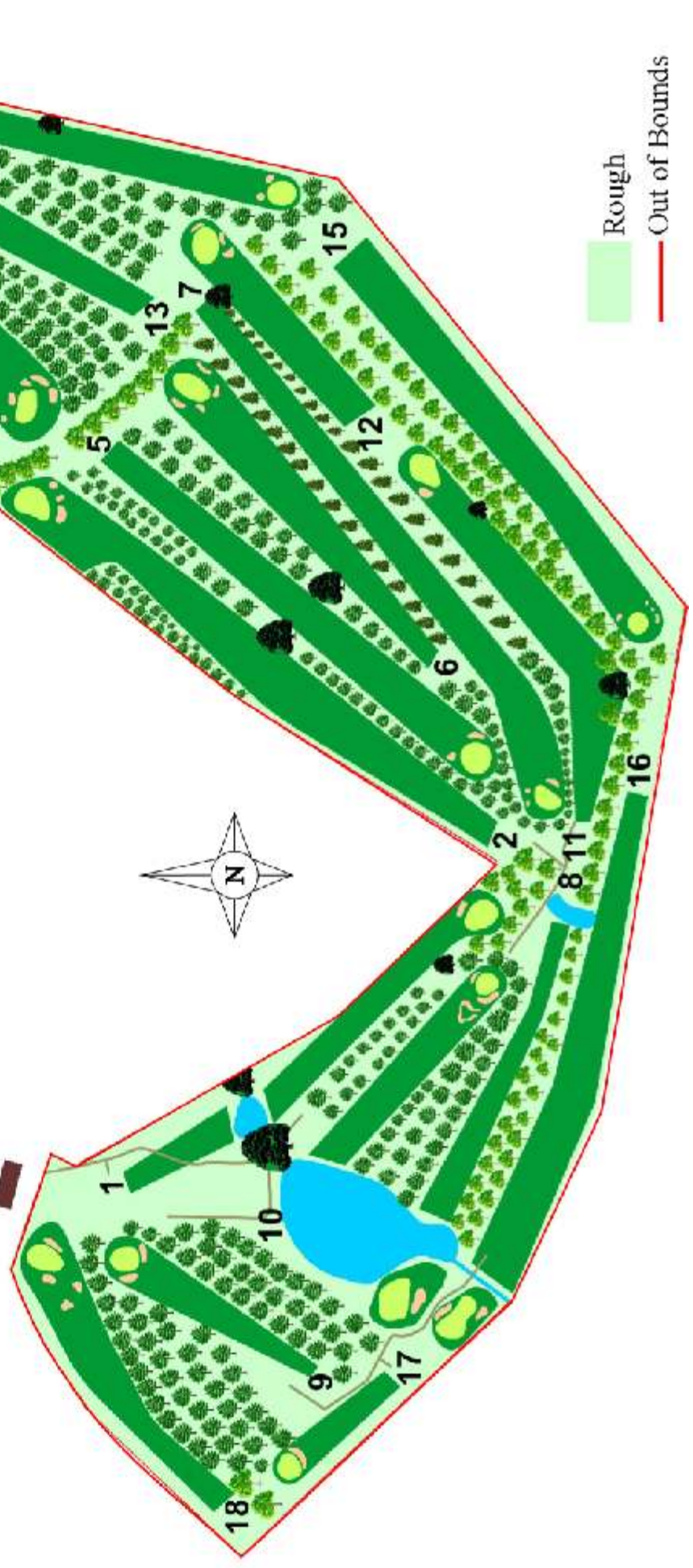

## **The Locker Room**

This new extension hosts our carvery, and also our new bar and grill restaurant.

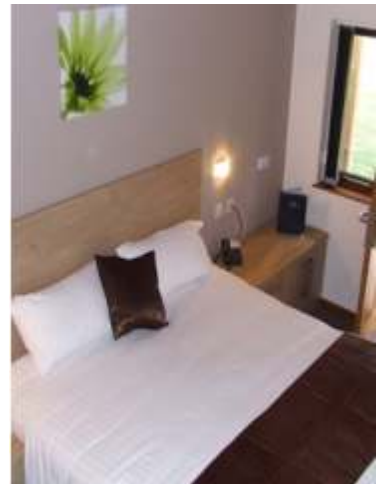

If you wish to play in competitions, which are on a weekly basis and range from midweek stablefords and medals to the major competitions and winter league, you will need a handicap. # MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 **Membership.** If you sign this agreement, you agree to become a member of the club referred to overleaf. Your relationship with the club is governed by these terms and the club's rules. In so far as the club's rules differ, these terms will apply.
- 2 **Membership Period.** You agree to remain a member of the club for at least the 'Minimum Term' agreed by yourself overleaf. Your membership will automatically be renewed thereafter for a further minimum period of 12 months until you cancel your membership. Your membership will, at the end of each minimum period, automatically renew for a further minimum period of 12 months until you or the club cancel your membership.
- 3 **Cancellation.** You cannot cancel your membership until you have been a member for at least the 'Minimum Term' agreed by yourself overleaf. Thereafter you may only cancel your membership by providing Calderfields Golf and Country Club with at least three month's prior written notice of your intention to do so, such notice to expire at the end of the second or any subsequent minimum period of membership. In this connection, nothing you say or write to the club and nothing the club says or writes to you will bind Calderfields Golf and Country Club.
- 4 **Payment.** (a) The initial payment specified overleaf and all subsequent membership subscriptions must be paid in full to Calderfields Golf and Country Club. All subsequent membership subscriptions are payable at the agreed date each month. Please note that additional charges may be required for certain services.  
(b) If you fail to pay any monies due under this agreement or if any Direct Debit is unpaid or any cheque is returned unpaid or if any other form of payment is not honoured for whatever reason, you shall pay us on demand an administration fee of £5.50.  
(c) Membership subscription rates may be reviewed after the Minimum Term (or any renewed term of membership). In the event that they are changed, you will be given 14 days written notice.
- 5 **Termination.** Your membership may be terminated if you breach this agreement or the club's rules and the breach is (a) serious (b) has not been remedied within 7 days of receipt of a written warning or (c) is repeated within 6 months of receipt of a written warning. In that event, all sums due will become payable immediately including the balance of the minimum membership period less 1%. In the event that we take action in order to obtain any sums due and owing to us by you, we reserve the right to recoup in addition all reasonable costs and expenses incurred up to a maximum sum equivalent to 2 months membership fees.
- 6 **Your Rights.** The club will compensate you if you suffer a personal injury or die as a result of its negligence. The club will compensate you if you suffer any other loss as a result of its failure to carry out its obligations under this agreement provided that its failure did not occur as a result of your own fault or your loss could not have been avoided even if the club or any third parties acting on its behalf had taken reasonable care. Nothing in these terms will reduce your statutory rights. If you need further information about your statutory rights contact a Citizens Advice Bureau.
- 7 **Data Protection.** If you do not pay everything you owe or make any payments late Calderfields Golf and Country Club may pass on information about you to financial and other organisations. This may affect your credit rating. Subject to that exception, your personal details will not be disclosed to outside organisations and/or individuals without your written consent.
- 8 **Jurisdiction.** This agreement will be governed by the law of England and Wales. Any disputes arising under it must be dealt with by the courts of England and Wales.
